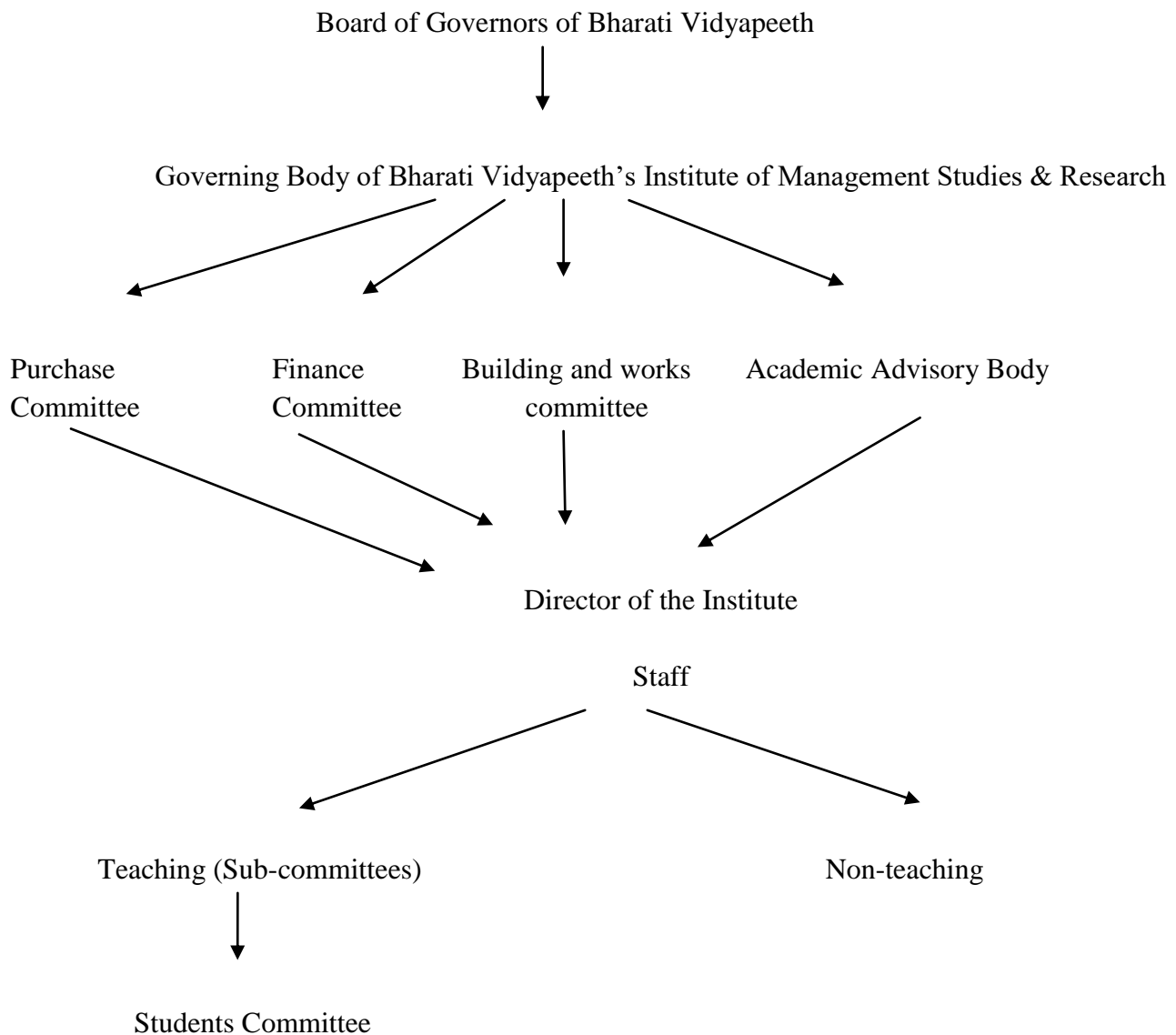

Nature and Extent of involvement of faculty and students in academic affairs/improvements:

- **Placement Facilities -**

The Institute has a separate Placement Cell backed by professionals from the industry who interact and guide students on a regular basis. The Cell has continuous contact with different organizations. Experts from the industry visit the campus and have interaction with the student community.

The Placement Cell constantly interacts with the top Executives in the Industry. It invites Corporate for Pre-Placement Talks with the students in the Institute. The Cell actively co-ordinates with Guest Faculty and invites experts from the Industry to share their experiences with the students.

It conducts Personality Development Programmes, Workshops and Seminars in consultation with faculty and students. It designs Placement Brochure with the co-ordination of the students. The Placement Brochures are sent to Companies and also to the Placement Agencies. Many Companies have dedicated placement agencies on their panel and don't entertain direct contacts with the job-seekers.

The persons attached to the Cell keep a close contact with the companies by visiting their HR Heads or CEO's at regular intervals for placing the students in their respective organizations. It makes arrangement for conducting campus interviews for final year students and arranges summer placements for the first year students. It gives counseling to the students and guides them in making their summer projects and final projects.
